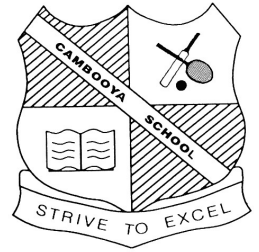

Dear Parents and Friends

NAIDOC parade:

Each year our NAIDOC parade is a significant event in our school year. The parade on Friday was no exception and I felt that it represented a great culmination of our NAIDOC week. Special thanks must go to all staff, students and parents who contributed to our NAIDOC activities through the week. We had a wonderful turnout to the parade and I would like to thank all of the community members and parents who made the effort to come along. I would like to acknowledge the Moodie family who concluded our NAIDOC parade with their amazing didgeridoo playing.

Excursions of this week:

This is a busy week for the school as we have two excursions to Toowoomba. The year five and year six students have headed to the Cobb and Co-Museum today to the "Have a look Captain Cook" activities focusing on our Indigenous culture. On Tuesday and Friday this week the Year 4s will be undertaking their bike education course which was postponed before the holidays due to bad weather. This is a great learning opportunity for the students to keep them safe when they are riding their bikes in the community.

Friday Parade:

Our parade on Friday will feature a flag presentation by our local member Mr Pat Weir who will present us with a new Australian Flag. We will also hold the presentation of the Athletics Aged Champion medallions. Year 4 students will be away at this time and other arrangements will be made to present the medallions to the Year 4 students. Parents of these students will be informed when this will occur.

Threshold Strategy:

- If you know of others starting school or moving to Cambooya next year

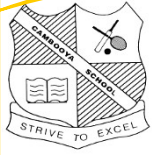
It makes life a lot easier knowing the enrolment numbers early!!!

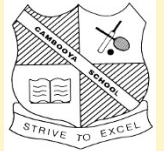
